First Redetermination Date

Program Issue: New regulations for the child care assistance program, now known as Care 4 Kids, became effective January 1, 2002. This transmittal gives clarification on the effective date of the first redetermination after an application is granted.

Policy Directive: Section 17b-749-18 (b)(1) of the Regulations of State Agencies reads, "Eligibility shall be redetermined at intervals not to exceed six months from the month assistance is granted or from the last redetermination." At application, assistance is granted effective until the end of the six month period starting the month after the month in which the action to grant is taken. Certificates of payment are issued for the period from the initial date of eligibility to the end of the month in which the redetermination is due. For example, an application is received on October 1st and granted on November 28th. The initial date of eligibility in this example is September 15th and the redetermination is due in the month of May. Certificates of payment are issued for this case from September 15th to May 31st. Eligibility is granted for a maximum of six months from the month the application was processed.
