Subject: **Confirming Family Assets**



Program Issue: In the Care 4 Kids Regulations 17b-749, family assets are not defined or required to be verified.

Background: The Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 2014 Pub. L. 113-186 and 45 CFR § 98.4 Section 658P(4) defines an eligible child as follows:

The term 'eligible child' means an individual—

“(A) who is less than 13 years of age;

“(B) whose family income does not exceed 85 percent of the State median income for a family of the same size, and whose family assets do not exceed \$1,000,000 (as certified by a member of such family).

Policy Directive: Every family who applies or requests ongoing assistance at redetermination must attest that their family assets do not exceed \$1,000,000. For families who submit an application or redetermination package where the asset question is not answered or indicates family assets exceeding \$1,000,000, an outbound call must be made to confirm whether the family's assets exceed \$1,000,000.
